Stryker, Director of the Farm Security Administration historical section, and three F.S.A. photographers, Russell Lee, Arthur Rothstein and Ben Shahn, will speak at a symposium at the Museum of Modern Art on Thursday, October 25, at 8:30 p.m. René d'Harnoncourt, Director of the Museum, is moderator.

The symposium is held in connection with The Bitter Years: 1935-1941, an exhibition of 200 photographs selected by Edward Steichen from 270,000 taken for the F.S.A. to record the plight of the farm population during the Great Depression.
