Mrs. Lyndon Baines Johnson will open the new galleries and enlarged Sculpture Garden of The Museum of Modern Art before an invited audience, Monday evening, May 25. Dr. Paul Tillich, Professor and theologian, will deliver an address at the opening which is planned as a tribute to the artists. William A. M. Burden, President of the Museum, will welcome the guests at the ceremonies which will be held in the Sculpture Garden at 10:30 p.m.

The Museum's 30,000 regular Members will be invited to preview the new galleries on Tuesday, May 26 prior to the public opening Wednesday, May 27.

The new additions and remodeling which will more than double the Museum's exhibition space have been designed by Philip Johnson Associates. The Museum galleries have been closed since December in order to complete the building program.

Art in a Changing World: 1884-1964 is the theme for the opening exhibitions which will present a panoramic view of the art of our time.
