Rudolf George Stern, son of Dr. and Mrs. Kurt G. Stern of New Haven, has joined the teaching staff of the Institute of Modern Art's Art Center at The Museum of Modern Art in New York City. Mr. Stern, a painter, was born in New Haven in 1936.

Now a resident of New York City, Mr. Stern instructs a class in painting and figure study for young people aged 15 to 19. Classes are held in a recently completed wing at the Museum.

Mr. Stern studied with Hans Hofmann in Provincetown and with Oskar Kokoschka in Salzburg. His work has been exhibited in group shows in Provincetown; Ames, Iowa, at the State University; and in Europe; and in a one-man exhibition in Galleria San Matteo, Genoa, Italy.
