Henry Pearson, who was born in Kinston, North Carolina, in 1914, is one of twenty artists from Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Japan, Spain and Switzerland, as well as the United States, represented in TWENTY DRAWINGS: NEW ACQUISITIONS on view at The Museum of Modern Art in New York through October 2.

Mr. Pearson, who now lives in New York City, studied at the University of North Carolina and later received a MFA in scenic design from Yale University. In 1953, after military service in this country and the Orient, Mr. Pearson studied at the Art Students League under Reginald Marsh, Will Barnet and Edwin Dickinson.
