- 1942 Created by Victor D'Amico, Director, Department of Education, The Museum of Modern Art, to demonstrate art education techniques and philosophy as developed in the Museum's art school for children. The Carnival also serves as a training workshop for teachers and offers parents and teachers an opportunity to observe children engaged in a variety of creative activities.
- Presented at The Museum of Modern Art periodically for more than 20 years.
- 1957 Presented by The Museum of Modern Art in connection with International Trade Fairs in Milan, Italy, and Barcelona, Spain.
- 1958 Featured in the United States Pavilion at the Brussels World's Fair in Belgium.
- 1962* Presented as a gift to Mrs. Indira Gandhi for the National Children's Museum in New Delhi, India, by Mrs. John F. Kennedy on behalf of the International Council of The Museum of Modern Art and The Asia Society.
- Toured major cities of India.
- 1969 Especially designed for the Harlem community at The Harlem School of the Arts by Victor D'Amico. Created and sponsored by The Museum of Modern Art. Installed by Victor D'Amico and Frank Vitullo.
