ORPHEUS TO APPEAR AT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

JAZZ IN THE GARDEN CONCERT SERIES

Orpheus, a singular four member soft-rock group, will appear at the Jazz in the Garden concert series at The Museum of Modern Art (11 West 53 Street), Thursday, July 31 at 8:30 p.m.

The group, on the MGM label, includes Bruce Arnold on lead guitar and vocals, Jack McKenes, second guitar and vocals, John Eric Gulliksen, vocals, bass, and bass guitar, and Harry Sandler, drums and percussion.

Following Orpheus on August 7th will be the Pacific Gas and Electric rock group who achieved popularity earlier this season at the Fillmore East.

Admission to all concerts is 75 cents in addition to the regular Museum entrance fee. All ticket holders are entitled to enjoy Museum facilities including galleries and film showings. Dinner and light refreshments are available. Tickets may be purchased in the Museum Lobby and are available up to concert time. The Museum of Modern Art is a non-profit educational organization.
