POSTERS IN THE PENTHOUSE, a special holiday exhibition/sale presented by The Museum of Modern Art's Art Lending Service, offers a selection of over 50 French and American exhibition posters of the 1940s, 50s, and 60s. The works are on view in the sixth-floor Members Penthouse from December 6 through February 6, 1978.

Some of the posters are reproductions of famous works, while others consist of new images created especially for the poster, by such notable artists as Braque, Cocteau, Indiana and Rivers. Many of the posters are rare and several are signed and numbered. Also on view are pairs of posters before and after lettering by Kandinsky, Lichtenstein, Matisse, Miro, and Warhol.

The posters are framed in clear plexiglas frames with a removable bronze banding especially designed for The Museum of Modern Art. The framed posters retail for the most part from \$150 to \$250.

POSTERS IN THE PENTHOUSE is open to the public through the Art Lending Service entrance at 21 West 53 Street from 11:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily, Sundays from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m., and through the Museum's main entrance from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. daily except Wednesdays.

The Art Lending Service, a project of the Museum's Junior Council, is a sales/rental gallery on the sixth-floor offering works in various media selected from galleries and independent artists. Works are for sale to both members and non-members; rental is a Museum membership privilege.
