THE NEW MANHATTAN BRASS QUINTET will present works by Susato, Farnaby, Maurer, Brahms, Hindemith, Debussy, Bozza and Horovitz at 8 PM, Friday and Saturday, June 9 and 10, 1978 in The Museum of Modern Art's SUMMERGARDEN.

Free admission is through the Sculpture Garden gate at 8 West 54th Street.

The New Manhattan Brass Quintet is comprised of Ralph Schwartz and James Dooley, trumpets; Damon Sgobbo, horn; Howard Prince, trombone; and Richard Schneider, tuba.

The Quintet has been selected for Artists International Special Presentation Series resulting in its forthcoming Carnegie Recital Hall debut.

The Quintet was formed in September of 1977 and its members have been heard individually and as a quintet in collaboration with The Long Island Chamber Ensemble and in frequent performances in the New York - Connecticut area.
