BRASS PROUD -- THE ART OF JAZZ TRUMPET -- in SUMMERGARDEN

BRASS PROUD, a jazz group sporting six trumpets and percussion, will give performances at 8 PM, Friday and Saturday, June 23 and 24, 1978, in The Museum of Modern Art's SUMMERGARDEN.

Free admission is through the Sculpture Garden gate at 8 W. 54 St.

BRASS PROUD consists of NORMAN SPILLER, MALACHI THOMPSON, KAMAL-ABDUL ALIM, OLU DARA, OLIVER BEENER, and FRANK GORDON, all on trumpets, and VICTOR LEWIS, drums, HAKIM JAMI, bass, and RAFIK RAHEEM, piano.

The group was formed by accident one day when no one except the trumpet players arrived for a rehearsal of another band. They "jammed" and have been together ever since, extolling the art of jazz trumpet.

SUMMERGARDEN, made possible by a grant from MOBIL, is a series of free events and free viewings of The Museum of Modern Art's Sculpture Garden. Entrance is through the Garden gate at 8 West 54th Street from 6 PM to 10 PM every Friday, Saturday and Sunday through September 3, 1978.
