NEW TRUSTEES AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Mrs. Melville Wakeman Hall, David Rockefeller, Jr. and Richard S. Zeisler have been elected new Trustees of The Museum of Modern Art, William S. Paley, Chairman of the Board, announced today.

Mrs. Hall has been a member of the Museum's International Council since 1970. She and her late husband William Jaffe made possible the Museum's acquisition of a notable selection of 16 Munch prints. She is now married to Mr. Melville Hall and resides in New York City and Palm Beach, Florida.

Mr. Rockefeller is a graduate of Harvard College, Harvard Law School, and Cambridge University and is a member of the New York Bar. He has also received an honorary degree of Doctor of Fine Arts from the California College of Arts and Crafts. In the past several years, he has served such arts and educational organizations as the Boston Symphony Orchestra; Art, Education and Americans, Inc.; American Council of the Arts; National Public Radio; Music Panel for the National Endowment for the Arts; Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center; the Massachusetts Governor's Task Force on Educational Opportunities in the Arts; and the Advisory Committee on the Arts for Harvard University.

Mr. Zeisler, a noted collector of modern master paintings, has served as Chairman of the Program Committee of the Museum's International Council since 1973. He has also been a member of the Museum's Committee on Painting and Sculpture since 1972. He is a director of the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center and a Trustee of the Baltimore Museum of Art.
