Dalton Bookseller, Minneapolis (1968-73).

Raised in Vermont, Mr. Edwards has a B.A. from Harvard College and an M.A. from the University of Minnesota, where he was also an instructor in English (1964-66). He was a Fulbright Scholar to England in history (1967-68).
