DANIEL W. VECCHITTO APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Richard E. Oldenburg, Director of The Museum of Modern Art, recently announced the appointment of Daniel W. Vecchitto as Director of Development. Mr. Vecchitto, who assumed his position on May 10, 1988, reports to Sue B. Dorn, the Museum's Deputy Director for Development and Public Affairs.

Mr. Vecchitto comes to the Museum from the University of Pittsburgh, where since 1986 he had served as Director of Development of Health Sciences. Among other previous positions, he was Associate Director of Development and Deputy Director of the Campaign for Yale Medicine at the Yale University School of Medicine (1983-86), Associate Development Director at the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution in Massachusetts (1982-83), and Director of Development at Merrimack College, North Andover, Massachusetts (1979-82).

Mr Vecchitto earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Saint Michael's College, Vermont, where he graduated cum laude.
