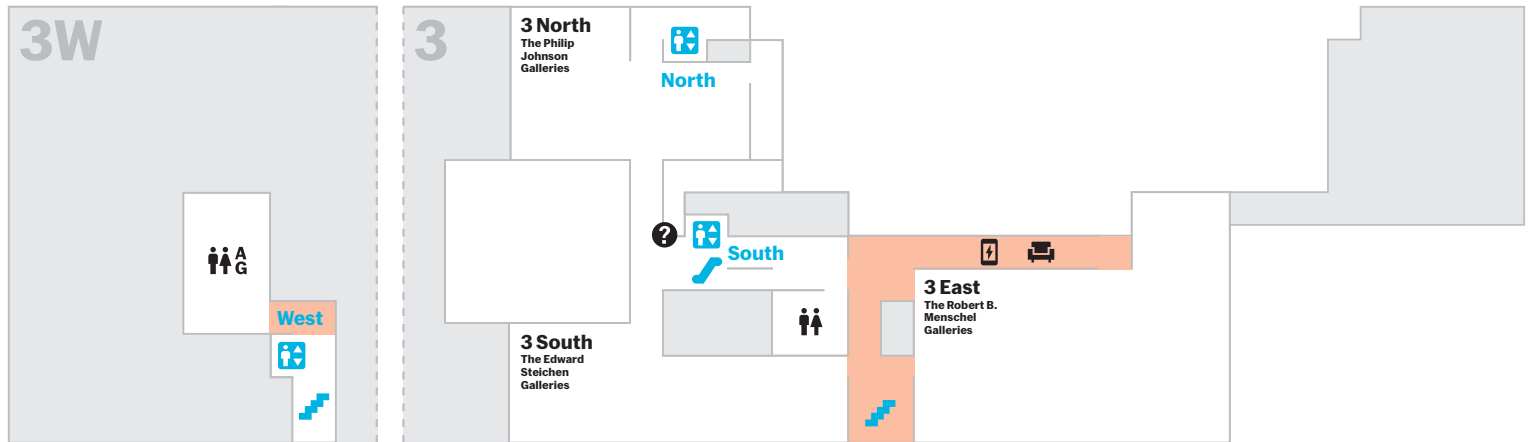
Welcome to The Museum of Modern Art. You can use this as a guide for finding spaces that tend to be quieter and less crowded, and spaces that have low or natural light and seating.

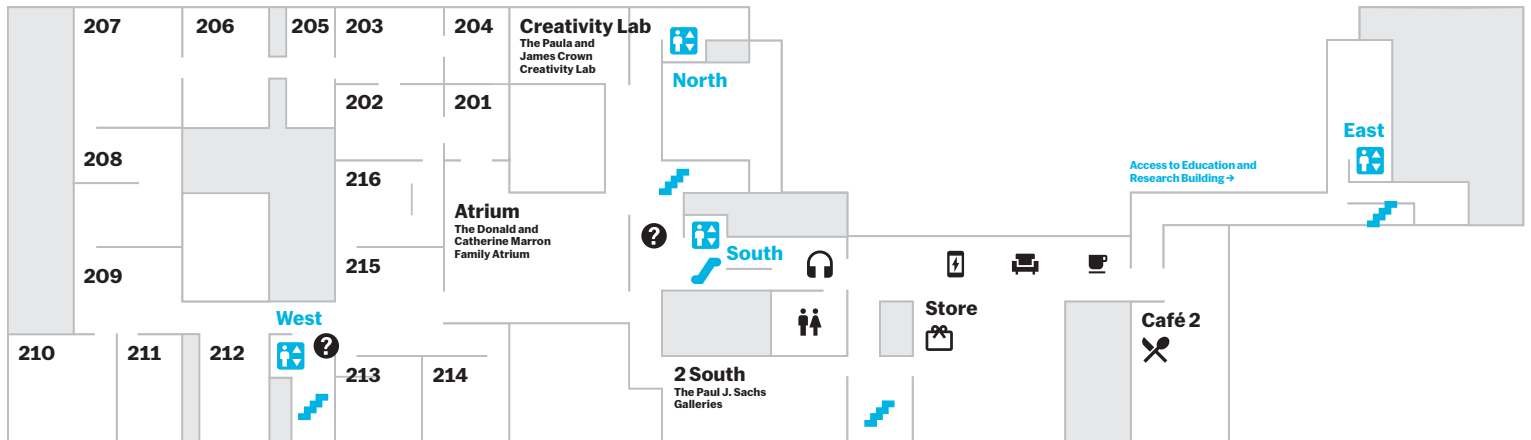
